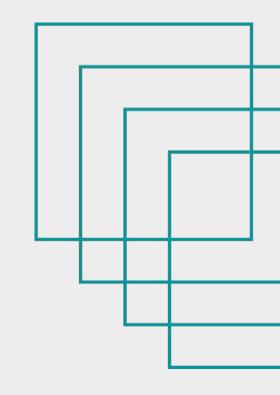

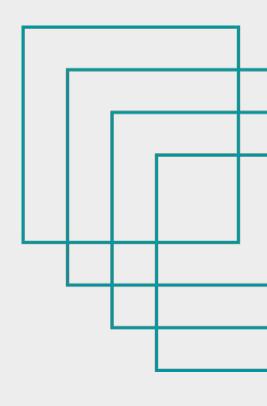

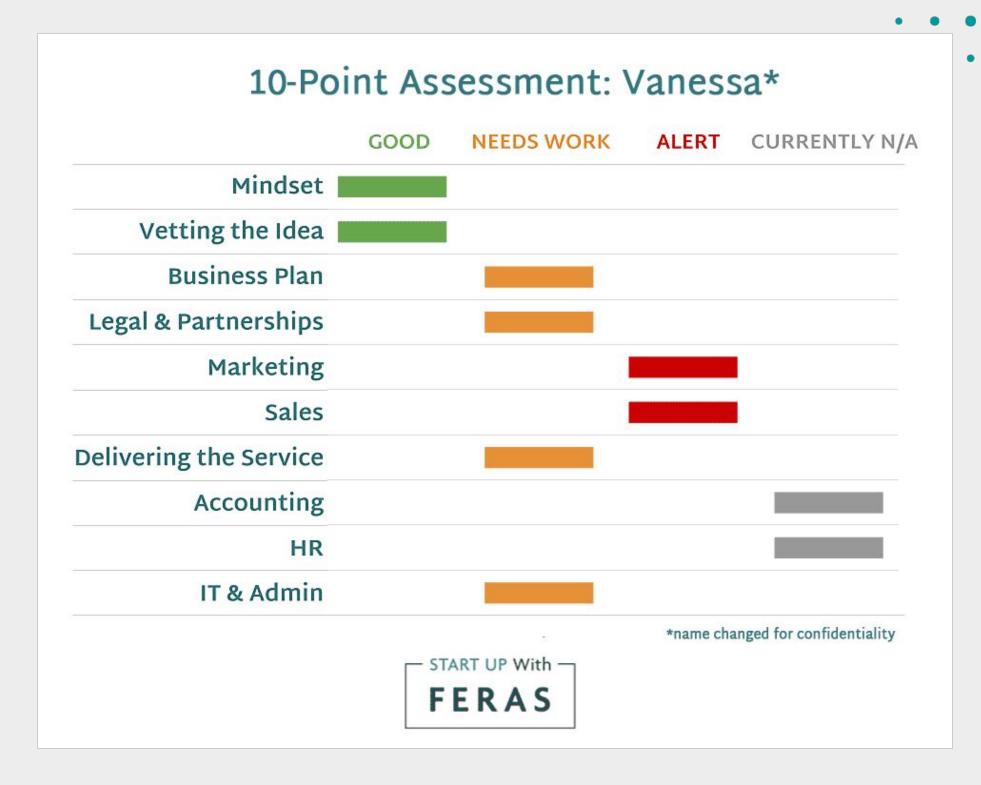


# Key Challenges

- Scaling: transition from solopreneurship by gradually building a team for growth
- Diversify client base: expand services (admissions advising) or target new markets (MBA applicants, professionals needing resumes/cover letters)





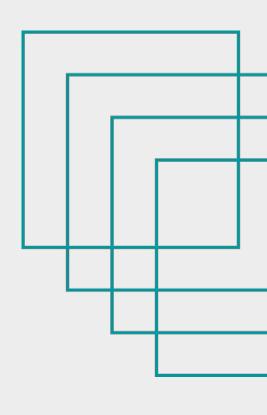
## Results Delivered

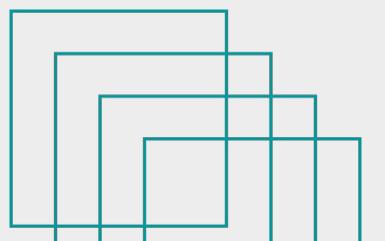
- Vanessa created a timeline to implement recommendations
